News from China...

Composition Competition: In January of 2004 the Chinese Accordion Association held the 2nd original composition contest for accordion in China. There were a total of 36 compositions entered into this competition which offered First, Second and Third prizes. In May 2004, the award ceremony for the prizes in the original composition of accordion in China took place.

Beijing Concert: On March 26th and 27th, 2004 two accordion concerts were held in the Golden Sail Odeum in Beijing. The young performers that were featured were from Tianjin, Xi'an and Sichuan Conservatory of music. They performed the musical compositions of Bach, Semionov, Aneglis, Zubitsky, Piazzolla and others.

Anqing City Competition: From July 29th - August 1st 2004 the national competition of accordion soloists took place in Anqing City of Anhui province in China. About one thousand contestants from all over the country entered this competition.

Solo Competition: From October 2nd - October 5th 2004 the First National Solo Performance Competition of youth took place. Nearly 400 contestants from the entire country entered for the solo contest and at the same time, 16 concerts of different styles were performed for the performance contest. The winner will be judged from one of these concerts which are just under one hour in length.
