## MORE BASSES "BY THE NUMBERS"



The DIATONIC SEVENTHS of the right hand may be harmonized more satisfactorily if the V7 CHORD is used instead of $V$ MAJOR.
Since the DIATONIC SEVENTH CHORD OF VII is the same as the V9th chord (in the treble), it may be harmonized by playing the COUNTERBASS of V (which actually IS VII), together with the V7 CHORD:
